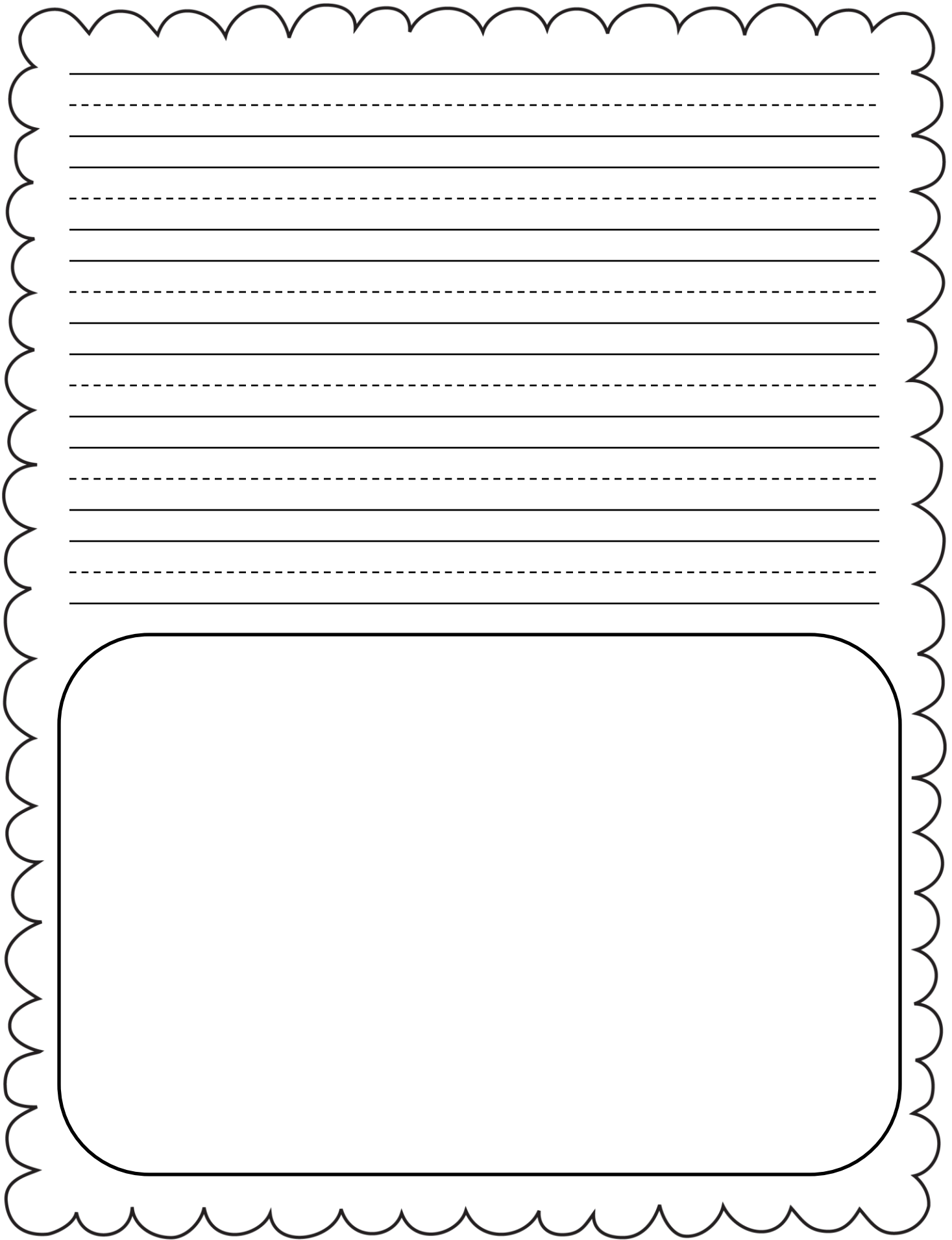

Singular and Plural Nouns

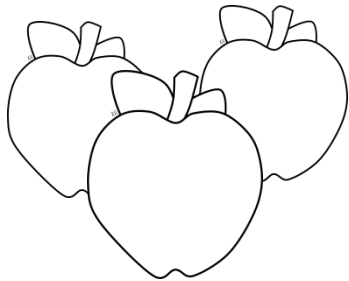
